Learn a lesson from the fig
tree, when you see these
things happening, he is
near.

To the point: "Learn a
lesson from the fig tree."
What are we to learn? That
the annual greening of the fig
tree is a harbinger of new life
arising out of seeming
deadness. That the annual
gospel prediction of
apocalyptic destruction is a
harbinger that Jesus "is
near." Indeed Jesus' promise
that he will be near at the end
of times is a promise already
being fulfilled now. Life
arising from deadness has
already happened to Jesus.
It is already happening in us.
